<b>Grade 6 (includes grade 5)</b>	<b>6th Grade or Lower</b>	<b>AND</b>	<b>1/1/2006</b>
<b>Grade 8 (includes grade 7)</b>	<b>8th Grade or Lower</b>	<b>AND</b>	<b>1/1/2004</b>
<b>Grade 10 (includes grade 9)</b>	<b>10th Grade or Lower</b>	<b>AND</b>	<b>1/1/2002</b>
<b>Grade 12 (includes grade 11)</b>	<b>12th Grade or lower</b>	<b>AND</b>	<b>1/1/2000</b>
<b>PG (Post HS Graduate)</b>	<b>12th + 1 Year or Lower</b>	<b>AND</b>	<b>1/1/1999</b>

**Exceptions (please refer to current ECYSA Operational Rules for full details):**

- 1. Players in Grades 5-12 may play UP one Grade Group without waiver or restriction.**
- 2. Grade 6-8-10-12 Teams may play up one Grade Group without waiver or restriction.**
- 3. Grade 4 players may play up in Grade 6 if the conditions of ECYSA and Mass Youth Soccer policy are met.**
- 4. Grade 2 or younger players may play on a Grade 4 team if the conditions of ECYSA and Mass Youth policy are met AND a written waiver is received from the ECYSA Regional Vice President.**
- 5. Players may play up 2 Grade Groups if a written waiver is granted by the ECYSA Regional Vice-President.**
- 6. Players may play DOWN a Grade Group (based on Grade AND/OR DOB) only if a written waiver is granted by the ECYSA Regional Vice-President.**
